Procedure – General Rules

The measures concerning the following rules are effective immediately.

This notice is a reminder of the importance of the application of rules 3.2 and 3.3 of the General Rules of the Commercial Division, in order to update the *plumitif* of the Court.

These rules state that :

- 3.2 Every proceeding filed at the office of the clerk of the Commercial Division must contain on the first page, under the title of the proceeding, the sequential docket number of any related proceeding :

Example :

Contestation (Relating to proceeding #)

- 3.3 The onus is on the parties to check the court record or the docket in order to determine the correct sequential number of the related proceeding;

Please note that the Office of the Registry of the Superior Court will refuse proceedings that do not comply with the above mentioned rules.
